Kathleen Riddle
President and CEO Emeritus
Outreach

Kathleen Riddle is President and CEO Emeritus of Outreach, the agency she co-founded in 1980 to bring specialized drug and alcohol treatment services to adolescents and other underserved communities.



Through her progressive efforts, Kathy grew the agency into one of the largest and most respected substance abuse treatment service providers in New York. Under her leadership, Outreach was the first to offer specialized quality residential treatment to adolescents and is recognized as a premier provider of behavioral health and chemical dependency care for adolescents, families, women, women with children, and adults across diverse populations.

For more than 40 years, Kathy has advocated for greater access and care for those with addiction treatment needs. At Outreach, she expanded the agency's reach and continuum of services by building and opening programs throughout Queens, Brooklyn, and Long Island. She created the agency-wide strategy and overall vision and managed its growth. Under her direction, Outreach was named "One of the Best Companies to Work for in New York State" eight times since 2010. She also personally oversaw the design of Outreach's unparalleled, state of the art facilities, creating family-oriented, welcoming professional environments, a role she continues to provide as special advisor to the organization after she stepped down from her role as president and CEO in 2018.

Kathy began her career with NYC Youth Services and later became a drug education specialist and substance abuse prevention counselor with the NYC Board of Education. Working with elementary and then middle school students, Riddle saw firsthand the devastating effects of substance abuse on children and their families.

Kathy has remained a determined advocate for program development and access to treatment for substance use disorders. She serves on professional and advisory groups locally and nationally, including the Executive Boards of the Association of Alcoholism and Substance Abuse Providers (ASAP) of NYS, Therapeutic Communities Association (TCA) of New York, and Treatment Communities of America. Kathy is also a member of state advisory groups on Medicaid redesign, behavioral health reform for children, chemical dependency field talent management, and county advisory boards focusing on community mental health and alcohol and substance abuse service planning.

Riddle is a proud graduate of Elms College, from which she received the Distinguished Alumni Award in 2014. Also that year, she received ASAP's Women's Leadership Award. In 2015, she was honored by USA Networks as a USA Unites Award recipient, which recognizes individuals who have helped strengthen their communities and enrich the lives of others.

Matthew Aracich is president of the Building and Construction Trades Council of Nassau and Suffolk Counties representing 37 affiliates.

Matthew is one of a long line of building and construction trades workers and union members. A twin, he is one of four children born to his father, a Heat and Frost Insulator. His paternal grandfather was also a Heat and Frost Insulator contributing to his family's 100-year heritage in their local union.

Born in the Bronx, Matthew moved to Bayshore, Long Island when he was in his teens. He initially worked as a commercial diver, and then went to work for the U.S. government, first doing geological surveys, then as a Heavy Equipment Operator for the U.S. Navy.

It was in July of 1985 that he followed in his family footsteps by becoming a Heat and Frost Insulator in his own right. In 1988, he became a mechanic and a later foreman. He worked for one company almost exclusively while he was employed as a mechanic in the construction trade.

In 1999, Matthew became president of Local 12. Then, in 2004, he became Financial Secretary. In 2012 he started his tenure as business manager and financial secretary, which continued until January 2018 when he was unanimously elected to his current position as president. He now represents the council in all capacities, including political activities, while also securing strategies to grow more market share for the labor unions.

Matthew's accomplishments during his three-year tenure are many and his talents have not gone unnoticed from those in government. He has often been asked to testify on energy issues before legislators and government agencies and was even invited to the White House during the Obama Administration, where he gave a presentation on the benefits of mechanical insulation.
