

Dear Friends,

I am thrilled to welcome you to *Outreach's 40th Annual Metropolitan Luncheon - Back Together Again!* during what continues to be challenging times. We are delighted that you have chosen to join us for the return of our in-person annual luncheon. Today, on our milestone 40th Metro gathering, we celebrate the resilience and accomplishments of our clients and their families and recognize the extraordinary support and contributions of our colleagues in business and labor in helping Outreach to realize our mission of delivering high quality behavioral health services and training.

When we last gathered at Cipriani in December 2019, we could never have imagined the degree to which our world would completely transform just a few months into 2020. Ever since, and throughout these past two years, Outreach has transformed too, and we innovated, while remaining committed to making a difference in the lives of adolescents, adults, and families struggling with the devastating consequences of drug and alcohol addiction. Our mission took on even greater magnitude in the COVID era. Our doors remained open, physically, and virtually, ensuring a safe and therapeutic environment for the persons in our care, and assuring that our unique and vital health and behavioral health care programs were extended to New Yorkers in need. In the last two calendar years alone, we have been able to provide services to over 6,000 clients and their family members, with over 3,500 admitted into our treatment programs. Additionally, our Outreach Training Institute remarkably converted to distance-learning, keeping aspiring health and behavioral health care clinicians on course to a brighter future.

Despite the many challenges the pandemic brought and amplified, and incredibly so, Outreach saw some extraordinary achievements in 2020-21. In early 2020, our new Recovery Residence for Women in Brentwood opened to clients, with official ribbon cutting - socially distanced and livestreamed via Facebook – several months later. Outreach also began to provide outpatient services in Nassau County, as we assimilated the Roosevelt Educational Alcoholism Counseling Treatment Center (REACT) into the Outreach family, with an official County welcoming ceremony in August 2021. The new women's residence, along with our continued capacity in our residential and outpatient components throughout New York City and Long Island, affords Outreach an exceptional continuum of care for adolescents, adults and traditionally underserved client communities - so critical, particularly now.

Outreach has also continued its efforts to innovate by implementing the following initiatives:

- Expanding access for Opioid Use Disorder treatment services in Nassau/Suffolk Counties and in Brooklyn;
- Working closely with network providers and partners to expand clinical and peer support staffing, expand mobile treatment services, strengthen family, and case management services, support centralized intake, provide a series of trainings on evidence-based practices to workers in our field, and more;
- Opening an Article 31 mental health clinic at our Richmond Hill location, upon receiving approval from The Office of Mental Health (OMH). This allows Outreach to increase community access for mental health services;
- Opening a Recovery High School in Brentwood NY. This important model builds upon the strengths of a collaborative, recovery-focused approach to education and addiction recovery systems by acknowledging that students in recovery need these resources to continue their education while learning how to remain and live in recovery.

Outreach's achievements in all years are made possible by the generosity and commitment of our supporters. On behalf of the Outreach Board of Directors, our staff, and our clients, *I say thank you, thank you, thank you*, for sharing our pride, for standing with us during challenging times, and for continuing to help us make a difference in the lives of the people of New York. Best wishes for a safe and healthy holiday, as we welcome 2022, and all the best for the New Year.

Vincent Alvarez

President

NYC Central Labor Council, AFL-CIO

Vincent Alvarez was elected as the NYCCLC’s first full-time president, the first Latino president, in 2011; he was re-elected in 2015 and 2019. Vinny had previously served as assistant legislative director of the NYS AFL-CIO, spearheading various worker-related policy initiatives throughout the state. From 2007-2009, he was assistant to the executive director and then chief of staff of the NYCCLC.



A member of the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers (IBEW) since 1990, Vinny began his career with IBEW Local 3 in Flushing, New York, serving on numerous political campaigns, grassroots initiatives, and negotiating committees. During this time, he also coordinated hundreds of labor mobilization and campaign events on behalf of the NYCCLC’s affiliates. He was the lead organizer and marshal of the NYC Labor Day Parade, the nation’s oldest and largest worker parade.

Vinny is a Class C Director of the Federal Reserve Bank of New York; Board Chair of the Robert F. Wagner Labor Archives at New York University; a Vice President of the Consortium for Worker Education; a Principal Officer of Climate Jobs NY; a Board Member of the Greater New York Councils, Boy Scouts of America; a Board Member of the New York Building Congress; and a Board Member of the Remember the Triangle Fire Coalition. He serves on the national AFL-CIO State Federation and Central Labor Council Advisory Board as well as on the Advisory Board of the CUNY School of Labor and Urban Studies. He is also a member of Cornell University’s Worker Institute Advisory Council and the NYC Comptroller’s Advisory Council on Economic Growth through Diversity and Inclusion.

Vinny is a graduate of the State University of New York at Oneonta, where he majored in business economics.

Kyle Bragg

President
SEIU 32BJ

Kyle Bragg became president of 32BJ in July of 2019 after the sudden death of Hector Figueroa. At that time he was unanimously approved by the union's executive board. He was re-elected president in September of 2021. Under Kyle's leadership, 32BJ successfully negotiated the 2020 commercial contract which raised standards and wages for workers.



Prior to becoming president, Kyle served as 32BJ's Secretary-Treasurer. He has been a member of 32BJ for more than 35 years and grew up in the labor movement. His father was an organizer and vice president of 1199 SEIU from the 1960s through the early 1980s. Kyle began actively organizing himself when he led his first strike at the age of 16. He began his union activism as a member and shop steward of 1199 while he was a student at York College of City University.

In 2001, Kyle led the merger with Local 32E, bringing 9,000 Bronx and Westchester members into 32BJ. As Secretary Treasurer, he grew 32BJ's residential division to 35,000 members in New York City, Westchester County, Long Island and New Jersey. Under his leadership, 32BJ scored a big victory with the 2014 residential contract where members won raises of more than 11 percent over four years, with increased pension contributions from employers and no givebacks. Similarly, Bronx residential members had a big victory at the bargaining table in 2015 as they won raises, maintained benefits and won a new 401k contribution from employers that starts in the second year of the contract. These victories in the residential division set a strong foundation for the union's 2015 contract negotiations for commercial office cleaners.

Kyle now serves as trustee of several 32BJ funds and as chair of the union's social and economic justice committee. He is a member of the executive board of the National African-American Caucus of SEIU and serves on the international union's first Racial Justice Task Force. He previously served on the Security Guard Council of New York State.

Kyle lives in Queens with his wife and three children. He regularly gives back to his community and serves on Community Board 13 in Queens. He is a member of the NAACP and the A. Philip Randolph Institute, sits on the Board of Directors of the Southern Queens Park Association and serves as a board member and mentor at Our Brothers Guardian, a youth program in Queens. Kyle was appointed to the New York Charter Revision Commission, which reviews New York City's constitution.

When our Metropolitan Luncheon was conceived 40 years ago, Outreach was on a mission to establish our very first residence for troubled adolescents, bringing together business and community members in what would become our premier fundraising event. Our inaugural 1981 Metro gathering set us on the path to break ground for Outreach House in Ridgewood, Queens the following Spring. Opening in 1984, this trailblazing program became New York State's first addiction treatment program to provide specialized treatment to adolescents in an intensive residential setting!

In following decades, resources derived from the Metro campaign were essential in enabling Outreach to grow, enhance and diversify our mission, our care continuum, and our geographic scope. We extended our residential rehabilitation facilities, expanded our intervention and outpatient services, and established our extraordinary education and training institute, offering superior treatment, education, and professional training to communities from Brooklyn to Bellport, and reaching more and more New Yorkers in need. **In the past five years alone, Outreach has cared for more than 10,000 clients, admitting over 8,500, whose lives have been altered for the better.**

Today, 40 years later, your support will help us continue to provide vital, high quality services throughout New York City and Long Island, in our now ten (10) outpatient and residential treatment facilities... and to do this while we plan for the opening of our 11th - a residence for young adults - sometime in 2022-23.

For four decades, people, companies, unions and families like yours have help raise over **\$30 million** in critical private sector funds to allow Outreach to build the best ~ *union best* ~ and to save literally thousands of lives otherwise destined for disaster and tragedy. So a big, beautiful **THANK YOU** to all present today, helping us continue on this journey in building healthy lives.


Robert Lashinsky (Bob Lash)
