

Dear Friends,

I am honored to welcome you to Outreach's 42nd annual Metropolitan Luncheon - Building Stronger Communities Together. Today, we celebrate the power of community and how, together, we are helping to build healthy lives for our clients and their families. Thanks to your extraordinary generosity and partnership, Outreach can continue to provide individuals in need of substance use disorder and mental health treatment access to the care they need.

My deep gratitude to our extraordinary 2023 honorees, Ralph C. Bumbaca, Michael E. Hellstrom, Jr. and our dear Luncheon Chairman Daniel Kindbergh, for their involvement and wholehearted support of today's event, and also to our Luncheon Committee who have worked tirelessly year-round to ensure this Luncheon is a success, thank you! As civil rights leader Mrs. Corretta Scott King noted, "The greatest of a community is most accurately measured by the compassionate actions of its members." Indeed, among this year's honorees, our Luncheon Committee, and you, Outreach could find no greater nor more compassionate collaborators. Thanks to you all, this past year, we were able to take further steps to expand our services and meet the growing needs of our communities by:

- Completing construction on the long-awaited 25-bed Young Adults Residence on our Brentwood, Long Island-Crooked Hill Road campus. This new residence, scheduled to open in 2024, will provide care for individuals ages 18-25, an often-overlooked group who are battling addiction at alarming rates.
- Building a new partnership with other agencies in Queens to guarantee the borough's diverse community can more easily access wraparound treatment, recovery, and supports', including free transportation to and from wherever they are to and from services.
- Opening our first Integrated Opioid Treatment Program for people throughout the New York metropolitan area struggling with opioid use disorder. In just its first year, the program has earned the highest level of accreditation possible from the Commission of Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities in recognition of its efficiencies and efficacy in providing harm reduction to those in need.
- Securing support to build a much-needed Supportive Crisis Stabilization Center in Suffolk County, where the rate of overdose is among the highest in our State. The Center will offer 24/7 support for people in crisis but who do not pose harm to themselves or others, however, may be at a greater risk without immediate help.
- Developing new initiatives, including scholarship programs to attend our professional training program, the Outreach Training Institute, for free to increase New York's treatment workforce at a time when overdose and addiction rates continue to climb, and the need for skilled clinicians and caregivers is great.
- Converting our Women's Recovery Center in Brentwood to include a rehabilitation element to meet the growing need for this additional level of care.

All these efforts, along with the growing number of services provided at our residential and outpatient treatment programs in New York City and on Long Island, allow us to offer adolescents, adults and families exceptional care. On behalf of everyone at Outreach, I thank you for your partnership and support that enables us to make a difference in the lives of fellow New Yorkers. My best wishes for a safe, healthy, and happy holiday season.

Michael E. Hellstrom, Jr.

Vice President and Eastern Regional Manager Laborers International Union of North America

Mike Hellstrom is vice president and Eastern Regional Manager of the Laborers' International Union of North America (LIUNA). Representing more than 45,000 unionized workers in New York City, Long Island, New Jersey, Delaware, and Puerto Rico, LIUNA is known for its vibrant organizing and political action programs as well as its innovative labor-management funds and skilled and productive workforce.

A second-generation laborer, Mike has been a member of LIUNA since 1984 and a tireless advocate for the rights of workers for his entire construction career. Prior to his current position, he served as business manager of the 17,000-member Mason Tenders District Council of Greater New York and Long Island (MTDC) whose affiliate locals serve the construction, asbestos and hazardous materials, recycling and sanitation industries,



and lay faculty at New York Catholic schools. At MTDC, Mike helped create innovative, grassroots union-organizing campaigns like the multi-building trades union "Count Me In" movement, which fought to keep construction in midtown Manhattan 100% union.

In 1996, Mike was one of 1,000 members who volunteered to participate in an innovative union organizing training offered by the then-newly formed Laborers Local 79. Over the next two years, as one of the local's first full-time organizers, Mike led some of the most visible and successful organizing campaigns in Local 79 and labor history, including the famous campaign against Roy Kay, Inc.

With those successes, Mike was tapped in 1998 to help restructure a then-troubled New York sanitation and recycling union. Under his leadership as business manager, Laborers' Local 108 grew into a 2,200-member-strong union covering the waste and recycling needs of New York City, Nassau and Suffolk counties and the Hudson Valley. Mike remained business manager of Local 108 until his move to the MTDC in 2018.

In addition to his long union career, Mike is a U.S. Navy veteran, who served honorably in the Persian Gulf and Somalia from 1985 to 1989 aboard the USS Spiegel Grove.

Leave No Man or Woman Behind: Outreach's Commitment to Serving Veterans

"Leave no man or woman behind."

Variations of this quote are found in the Soldier's Creed for all branches of service and imbedded in our programs and services for veterans here at Outreach. We are committed to ensuring that every veteran who comes through our doors knows that we are here to support them through their recovery journey and transition back to civilian life.

Men and women who have served this country and are in need of drug and alcohol treatment deserve a specialized treatment approach that is uniquely designed for them. Their experiences, communication styles, and distinctive set of traumas, call for counselors who can speak their language. At Outreach, our dedicated staff of treatment professionals include those who are veterans themselves. Their shared experience lends credibility for veterans, and helps them feel comfortable in their treatment environment, and therefore increases the likelihood that they will complete their treatment program.

As a behavioral health provider, Outreach is committed to using the latest evidence-based practices in our services for veterans, including Seeking Safety which focuses on PTSD, Strength of the Struggle, Trauma-Informed Care and more. Our Outpatient program for veterans offers both individual and group therapy sessions, as well as case management and vocational services, where we address drug use, co-occurring issues, and life skills deficits. The focus is not just on past traumas but also on grounding and identifying coping skills on how to heal from those traumas.

Our Outpatient program houses a veterans' lounge which provides a quiet and supervised retreat where veterans can search for jobs, and socialize and connect with other veterans. Most of the group sessions for veterans are held in the veterans' lounge, and discussions range from relapse prevention, to mindfulness, to emotional regulation, grief and loss, and creative arts therapy.

Outreach recently welcomed a new fulltime Veterans' Counselor, Danielle "Dani" Koulermos, to help facilitate groups and administer art therapy. According to our Outpatient Services Director Thomas Olivo, "We felt Dani was our missing link. We are thrilled to have her onboard and deepen the work with our clients who are veterans."

Dani Koulermos shared that oftentimes after discussing their feelings and past trauma in groups many veterans find it hard to identify the language to explain why they feel a certain way. Art offers a way to express something that has happened to them or is happening in the moment, without having to use words and share too much about their past. "Clinical art therapy is a growing modality within the mental health umbrella which services allow people to create rather than speak," says Koulermos. "Art can be anonymous so whether the barrier is shame, confusion, memory loss or just lack of words to describe what we have lived through. Art making allows the vessel to process trauma with a clinician in a safe space without using triggering details of storytelling." Art therapists who practice trauma informed care can help direct veterans suffering from PTSD graduate to post traumatic growth by using psychoeducation to help teach and learn about their emotional triggers, creating their own personal narrative, and encouraging acceptance by being open and honest about their recovery. Art therapy is very versatile because you can choose so many different mediums like music in song writing, passages from books, motivational speeches on audiobooks as well as the traditional tools like drawing, painting, and sculpture. Utilizing art therapy, the clients have the autonomy to choose what they would like to use and what they feel comfortable exploring. For our clients at Outreach, and veterans alike, choice is something that they have not always had throughout their lives, whether it be in the military following orders, being incarcerated, or addicted to substances itself. So having the choice over which medium to use or what they design is paramount in their recovery to make good decisions and trying new things."

Veterans can also take part in Outreach's new 16-bed intensive residential treatment program which is centered around the evidence-based Rehabilitation to Care practice. The program, which lasts approximately 28 days (though the length of stay is ultimately based on the individual's needs) offers the skills necessary to establish sobriety. Upon completion of the program, veterans are referred to the next appropriate level of care, either residential living or outpatient treatment. All options are explored, discussed, and determined in collaboration with the client to ensure that they are fully engaged in the continuation of their recovery. Clients also have access to veteran support groups and community resources through Outreach. These services include referrals to agencies that can help them overturn an dishonorable discharge status in order to be eligible for military benefits.
